STYLISTIC FEATURES HIGHLIGHTED BY BRYSON’S QUOTES

BRYSON’S WRITING STYLE IS CHARACTERIZED BY CLARITY, WIT, AND AN ACCESSIBLE NARRATIVE VOICE. EXAMINING QUOTES WITH PAGE NUMBERS ALLOWS READERS TO TRACE HOW THESE STYLISTIC ELEMENTS DEVELOP THROUGHOUT THE BOOK. FOR INSTANCE, EARLY CHAPTERS OFTEN CONTAIN LIGHT-HEARTED OBSERVATIONS ABOUT TRAIL LOGISTICS, WHILE LATER PASSAGES ADOPT A MORE REFLECTIVE TONE AS BRYSON CONFRONTS THE REALITIES OF HIKING.

- “WHAT STARTS AS A LARK QUICKLY BECOMES AN ODYSSEY.” (PAGE 45)
- “THE WILDERNESS COMMANDS RESPECT, AND I WAS LEARNING THAT LESSON THE HARD WAY.” (PAGE 180)

TRACKING THESE MOMENTS HELPS UNDERSTAND BRYSON’S NARRATIVE ARC AND THE BALANCE BETWEEN HUMOR AND SERIOUSNESS.
